



DONOR BILL OF RIGHTS

To assure that philanthropy at SightConnection merits the respect and trust of the general public and that donors and prospective donors have full confidence in SightConnection, SightConnection declares that all donors have the following rights.

1. To be informed of SightConnection's mission, of SightConnection's intended use of financial and tangible donations and of its capacity to use donations effectively for the intended purposes.
2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on SightConnection Board of Directors and to expect the governing board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
3. To have access to SightConnection's most recent financial statements.
4. To be assured that their individual gifts to SightConnection will be used for the purpose for which they were given.
5. To receive appropriate and timely acknowledgement and recognition from SightConnection.
6. To be assured that information about their donation is handled by SightConnection with respect and confidentially to the extent provided by law.
7. To expect all relationships between SightConnection and the donor be professional in nature.
8. To be informed whether those seeking donations for SightConnection are volunteers, organization employees or hired solicitors.
9. To have the opportunity to have their names deleted from SightConnection's mailing list or any mailing list that SightConnection intends to share.
10. To feel free to ask questions about SightConnection when making a donation and expect prompt, truthful and complete answers.
